

1. Identify the front and rear upper clamp halves. Front clamps have a narrower gap than rear clamps.




Place the clamp halves on top of the vehicle frame rails on both sides of the truck in the approximate locations shown in the photo.

2. Lift the LH and RH bracket weldments to the bottom of the corresponding frame rail. Push each bracket tight against the protruding stud from the bottom of the frame rail before loosely threading four 5/8 inch x 6 1/2 inch hex bolts into the upper clamp halves.

Alternate tightening bolts from one side of the rail to the other to draw the upper and lower clamp halves together evenly.

 Fasten the mount plates of the prong weldment to holes in the LH and RH brackets with four 1/2 inch x 1 1/4 inch hex bolts and lock nuts.


Bottom edges of the pronges should measure about 10 inches above the ground when completed.

Headlight Removal


The following instructions are reprinted from the 2005 Dodge Dakota owner's manual. Follow these instructions when installing the mount kit headlight adapters.

- 2. Remove the three (3) screws attaching the headlamp housing to the inner panel.




Removing Attaching Screw
